Adults with heart failure with reduced ejection fraction

Management

Recommended for routine use:

- Angiotensin receptor blocker/nepriylsin inhibitor (AR/NI) or ACE inhibitors or ARBs in all patients, unless contraindicated, but drugs from these classes should not be used together
